

## LMS Back to School Information Sheet



### Tandem Calendar - lists every event in the district.

- Go to the parent or student page – click on the calendar link—see events for the entire district.
- Sort for middle school events by clicking on the sort light and selecting our building.
- Click the away event to get driving directions and many other options.

### Pinnacle Internet Viewer (PIV)

Each parent/child is given a confidential username and password for access to our online grading system for up to date grade information. Teachers and staff do not have passcode information. If you lose the code or cannot log in, please contact the guidance office (Mrs. Conti) and she can run a new letter for you. We are not permitted to give this information out over the phone. Midterm reports are no longer being sent home, so it is important to utilize this site for grade updates between grading periods. Share the information with your child, as they have the opportunity to view PIV in classes, as well.

- Click on the PIV link on the parent or student page
- Put in the username and password from the PIV letter. (Be sure Lake Local is selected as the domain.)

If students do not have computer access at home or by phone, the lake middle school library is open from 7:10am to 3:30pm during the week. The Stark County Public Library also has a limited number of computers available for library patrons.



Please refer to the following dress code guidelines when making decisions about what to wear to school:

- Wear clean clothes in good condition (free of holes or shreds).
- Wear shorts, skirts, or dresses that are at or below the knee.
- \*\*\*With proper undergarment such as: tights, leggings, jeggings and yoga pants, etc., a skirt or dress needs to be fingertip length.
- Tights, leggings, jeggings, and yoga pants are permitted with a long top or sweater; backside must be covered.
- Wear tops and shirts that cover the midriff, bra straps and shoulders.
- Wear clothing free of words, logos, symbols, trademarks, or other references to alcohol, drugs, sex, violence, profanity, cults, Satanism, or death.
- Place coats, hats or other head dresses in lockers upon entering the school.
- Place all book bags in your locker.
- *If you think some part of your dress is questionable – don't wear it!*

#### ADDITIONAL NOTES ON CLOTHING, HAIRSTYLES, CELL PHONES & MUSIC DEVICES

- Any form of dress or hairstyle which is considered contrary to good hygiene or which is distractive or disruptive to the purpose of education, will not be permitted. Hair that covers one's eyes or unnatural colored hair is prohibited. Failure to abide by these rules may result in confiscation and/or disciplinary action, including required clothing change.
- The dress code may be enforced at all school related activities including sporting events and dances. Failure to abide by these rules may result in confiscation and/or disciplinary action, including required clothing change.
- Cell phones and music devices (iPod, MP3, or any other type of music device along with headphones) are not permitted to be visible or turned on in school during the normal school day. Cell phones & music devices used or visible during the school day without express permission from a teacher will be confiscated. Parents may be required to pick up confiscated cell phones.
