

Phone/ipod use:

Students are NOT permitted to have their cell phone or ipod **on or visible** during the school day (7:20-2:30). If you send a message to your child, understand that they will not be able to receive it until 2:30pm. We prefer devices to stay in the locker or book bag, so there is no chance of it falling out in class. Sticking out of a pocket is considered VISIBLE. Please call the office (330-877-4290) if you need to reach your child during the school day and we will be happy to deliver a message or have him/her call you.

If a child is caught with his/her phone or ipod out during school, it will be confiscated. After a warning, the First offense could be up to 5 days, usually 3 days, 2nd offense is 5 days. A parent may come and pick up the phone at any time from the office/Mrs. Lyberger, but it will not be released back to the child until the set time is up. This may seem harsh, but we have found that students are very distracted by having a phone on them in classes. It is very tempting to check it, turn it on, etc. and then students are not engaged in the education process.
